American Cruise Lines operates coastal and inland waterway cruise ships on the East Coast and in the Pacific Northwest generally on 7 day cruises. The crew consists of approximately 16 to 30 crewmembers performing a wide range of tasks. Shipboard employees live onboard the ship while working.

The ships operate through most of the year. During summer months, the ships operate cruises in the New England area and Pacific Northwest. In the spring and fall months, the ships operate in the Mid-Atlantic region, and during the winter they generally cruise in Florida and the Southeast region.

Shipboard managerial positions include CAPTAINS, MATES, ENGINEERS, HOTEL MANAGERS, CHEFS, and CRUISE DIRECTORS. U.S. Coast Guard licenses are required for CAPTAINS, ENGINEERS and MATES. General positions aboard the ship include DECKHANDS, STEWARDS and GALLEY STEWARDS.

OVERTIME POLICY

Overtime for more than 40 hours per week is paid to hourly employees who work primarily on land, i.e. office personnel, sales people, reservationists, etc.

In accordance with applicable Federal Law, shipboard employees who work primarily on board company vessels will not receive overtime from the company, even when they are working on shore. These employees are exempt from the overtime under the "Fair Labor Standards Act," 29 U.S.C. Section 213 (b) (6), see also 29 CFR Section 783.32.

TRAVEL TO & FROM SHIP POLICY

The company will pay for transportation from a major city near your home to the ship and back to the major city near your home. This transportation will be arranged and paid for by the company and depending on the location of the ship and the domicile of the employee, it may be by airplane, train, rental car, taxi, or bus, or any combination of the above. All officers are paid for the days they work and are not paid for travel time or travel days. The travel policy may be amended or changed at any time.
